- 1 ST ANNE'S CATHEDRAL / THE MAC**
The MAC is home to international art exhibitions, live theatre and other weird and wonderful goings on. It's right beside St Anne's Cathedral, where visitors can learn about the cathedral's history and unique features.
- 2 THE CATHEDRAL QUARTER**
One of Belfast's most vibrant areas, the cobbled streets of the Cathedral Quarter are packed full of great bars, restaurants and live music.
- 3 VICTORIA SQUARE SHOPPING CENTRE**
Victoria Square Shopping Centre is the perfect spot to get your shopping fix. Make sure to check out some of the boutiques and vintage stores in the surrounding streets for something a little different!
- 4 BELFAST CITY HALL**
One of Belfast's best-known landmarks.
- 5 SAWER'S DELI**
One for the foodies! Sauer's is an Aladdin's cave of culinary delights, with an amazing selection of cheese, charcuterie and everything in between!
- 6 THE OPERA HOUSE**

- 8 ST GEORGE'S MARKET**
A must-visit for foodies and anyone interested in local crafts and artisan products. Open Fridays 6am – 3pm, Saturdays 9am – 3pm, and Sundays 10am – 4pm.
- 9 THE WATERFRONT**
Belfast's biggest conference and events venue overlooking the water.
- 10 TITANIC BELFAST**
Titanic Belfast is the world's largest Titanic visitor experience.
- 11 BOTANIC**
In the heart of Belfast's University Quarter, filled with quirky restaurants, coffee shops, book stores and more.
- 12 QFT**
This intimate cinema is perfect for film fans, showing the best in new and vintage film from around the world.
- 13 QUEEN'S UNIVERSITY BELFAST**
Founded in 1845, Queen's University has a rich heritage and beautiful architecture.
- 14 BOTANIC GARDENS & ULSTER MUSEUM**
Take a relaxing cycle through the Botanic Gardens and check out the exotic plants in the Palm House and Tropical Ravine. Come face to face with dinosaurs, get up close with an Egyptian mummy and dive into discovery zones at the Ulster Museum.
- 15 ORMEAU PARK**
A popular park near the coffee shops, bars and restaurants of the Ormeau Road. We recommend starting from the Waterfront area and following the signs for the Lagan and Lough Cycle Way until you reach the Ormeau Bridge.
